

Please make note of the following information:

SCHOOL DATES

September 8 – 9 – Teacher Professional Days School Closed. Remote Learning Materials Pick-Up by appointment. Parents will be notified of day and time.

September 10-11– Remote Learning for All students (Pre-K and K will follow their own schedule) begins at 8:30 – 12:30 – students will be invited to their teachers' Google classroom.

September 14 – In Person and Remote Learning begin for all grades. Lunch Program begins.

SCHOOL HOURS – GRADES Pre-K-8

There will be staggered start times and staggered dismissal times as follows:
Parents do not enter the building.

Grades Pre-k and K

8:15 Arrival, 2:45 Dismissal

Students will enter and be dismissed out the Pre-K/K door by the school playground.

Grades 1-3

8:00 Arrival, 2:45 Dismissal

Students will enter through the front door and dismiss through the door in the parking lot.

Grades 4-5

8:15 Arrival, 3:00 Dismissal

Students will enter and dismiss through the door to the parking lot.

Grades 6-8

7:45 Arrival, 3:15 Dismissal

Students will enter through the front door and dismiss through the door in the parking lot.

Before/Aftercare

Parents will be notified when before care and after care begins.

Students must be in summer uniforms.

Summer work must be returned to the teachers as per their due dates and instructions.

Parents/Guardians are expected to check their children for COVID-19 symptoms every day prior to arriving at school – Please note all students will have their temperatures taken at the door. Parents should not leave until student is checked as students with any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home.

- Keep your child home when sick. All students are required to wear appropriate face masks.

Social distancing will be enforced throughout the school day. Only students and faculty will be allowed to enter the building. This is for the safety of all. Please call the school office at 973-759-3143 if you have questions.

The students will not change classes. Teachers will move to the classes. Students will remain in the same classroom.

Students will be reminded and expected to sanitize their hands at appropriate times of the day. Hand sanitizer will be available in the classroom and throughout the school building.

Signage will be posted throughout the school to remind students to practice proper hygiene.

There can be no sharing of supplies. Students must have their own supplies such as pencils, crayons, scissors and whatever the classroom teacher requires.

Lunch will be delivered to each classroom. Extra time will be given for the students' lunch period.

Sneeze guards will be on students' desks. In order to maintain social distancing in hallways, taped guides will be placed on the floors in one way directions.

Disinfecting and Cleaning of the school will be done on a regular basis.

5 Day Remote Learning and 5 Day In-Person Learning are being offered. Google Classroom and Google Meets is the platform being used to deliver online instruction. Students are to follow their teachers' instructions and adhere to due dates. If remote learners are unable to join their class, call the school office immediately.

Remote Learners:

- Are to be dressed in their school uniforms when online.
- Teachers will take attendance.
- Have their cameras on.
- Follow their class' schedule (to be provided by the classroom teacher).
- Be on time to class – 8:30 start time.
- Submit work on time and as directed by your child's teacher.
- Drop boxes will be provided at school for work to be submitted that is not required by teachers to be sent through Google Classroom. Classroom teachers will apprise you of their requirements.

Remember although remote learning students are not physically present in the classroom, they are expected to adhere to St. Peter School's policies and rules.
